


National Bullying Prevention Week



Tips on how to teach sight words





How to teach Sight Words

- Read the word (with help if needed). was
- While tapping under each letter, say the letter name and then say the whole word while underlining it. (2x)
 w a s was
- While tracing each letter with the back of a pencil, say each letter then say the whole word while underlining it. (2x)
 w a s was
- While tracing the letters on table with two fingers, say each letter and then say the whole word while underlining it. (2x)
 w a s was
- While tapping each letter going down the left arm or up the right arm, say each letter and then the whole word sweeping hand down the left arm or up the right arm. (2x)
 w a s was
- Write the word in your notebook.
